


Figure 1 – Captive Eye Bolt Latching System






Figure 2 – Slam Latch Latching System

Mount Herd bracket to truck, with packers (Part of Item 1) for spacing on the bottom bolts using supplied Herd fasteners (Items 8, 10, 11) Note: If installer has a crane available, truck guard can be attached onto truck with bracket, otherwise disassemble truck guard from bracket first. Keep hardware. If bumper is equipped with lift assist, the springs must be removed. Refer to instructions S004 (Defender bumpers) or S005 (Aero/Texas bumpers) for proper lift assist disassembly procedure. 	8, 10, 11 Packer Packer
 6. Fasten the Herd Bracket (Item 1) to the Herd Loose Brackets (Part of Item 1) using the supplied ½" Nuts and Washers (Part of Item 1). Do this for both passenger and driver sides. Next ensure all seven mounting points are used on the Herd Bracket (Item 1). 	***********************************



Important

- Check mounting points after the first 5000 km and every 3-6 months.
- If this truck guard is equipped with Legacy Herd Slam Latch, periodic adjustment is required. Refer to Legacy Slam Latch Installation adjustment instructions to properly adjust your Slam Latch.
- The drop-forged eyebolts are an integral part of the strength of Herd Truck Guards. When tightened firmly, they will minimize vibration and provide superior impact resistance.
- To help maintain the factory finish, avoid acid wash.
