

- Unless otherwise specified, Grade 8 or Class 10.9 hardware is to be used. For the purposes of these instructions, OEM hardware means the truck's original factory hardware.




Figure A - VV05C4-02 Bill of Materials

Items marked with \* are not shown in Figure A above.

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1. Unplug OEM driving lights (if equipped) and remove from front bumper. The inside of the front bumper is accessed by removing the panel shown in figure 1.




Figure 2 – OEM Bumper Uninstall (Passenger Side Shown)

2. Remove the two flat head fasteners shown in figure 2, and maneuver the bumper off of the truck. The frontward two fasteners slide along a track allowing for the bumper to come off easily.

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3. Disconnect wiring harness from the OEM bumper mounting bracket.

4. Remove OEM bumper mounting bracket's fasteners. Repeat for passenger side.

### Note:

If the truck is equiped with a radiator cover, temporarily remove it for later installation.






Figure 4 – OEM Bumper Mounting Bracket Fastener Removal (Driver Side Shown)

5. Install the rear bracket of Herd Mounting Kit (Item 10) to the truck frame on both driver and passenger sides. Install using the provided hardware (Items 19, 27 & 28) at the bottom. Next insert the provided hardware (Items 21, 28, 29 & 30) to the OEM bumper mounting bracket. Install these hardware snug but not tight to allow adjustments.

Note: If the truck is equipped with a radiator cover, re-install the radiator cover under the rear bracket of Herd Mounting Kit (Item 10) as shown.




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6. Install the front bracket of Herd Mounting Kit (Item 10) using the provided hardware (Items 18, 19, & 20). Next, insert provided hardware (Items 22, 23 & 24) onto tow receivers. Prior to tightening ensure that the front bracket is level and adjust as necessary. Do this on both passenger and driver sides.




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7. Open bumper by pulling on the handle. Using a crane, lift the bumper (Item 12) and universal bracket (Item 7) and attach to Herd submounts (Item 10). Make sure to install at the lower set of mounting holes of Herd submounts (Item 10) as shown.

### Note:


If installer does not have a crane available, bumper can be disassembled from the universal bracket to simplify installation as shown in step 8, otherwise proceed to step 9.



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8. a) Ensure bumper is closed. From underneath the bumper, remove the 3/8" hardware securing the lift assist springs and slide off springs from the lift assist (Item 1).

b) Once the springs are removed, carefully open the bumper using the slam latch. Remove the 1/2" hardware securing the bumper to the universal bracket. Remove bumper and set aside on cardboard. Now the bracket is isolated for mounting without a lift.



9. Install universal bracket (Item 6) to submounts (Item 10) using the provided hardware (Items 18, 19, 20 & 21). Be sure to mount both driver and passenger sides.

#### Note:

The large washers are placed on the bracket (Item 7), small washers on the submounts (Item 10)




Figure 9 – Universal Bracket Submount Installation (Passenger Side Shown)

- 10. If bumper was disconnected from the universal bracket in step 8, reverse the procedure to mount bumper back onto the bracket.
  - a) First ensure the bumper hinges are open.
  - b) Attach using previously removed 1/2" bolts until the hinge just slightly touches the bracket.
  - c) Close the bumper and ensure the latch engages.
  - d) Open the bumper and tighten the bolts until they are snug.
  - e) Close the bumper again to ensure the latches engage properly.





Figure 10.1 - Bracket and Hinge Reassembly

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
- f) Fully tighten the ½" hardware to 110 ft·lb. Latches may need to be adjusted, refer to Slam Latch Adjustment guide (S012).
- g) Close the bumper and slide springs onto the lift assist shaft, ensuring that spring arms are inserted into slots of bumper. Reinsert 3/8" hardware securing the lift assist springs.



11. If equipped with OEM driving lights, remove driving lights from factory bumper and retain OEM hardware.


Mount OEM driving lights into the mounting bracket for both passenger and driver sides Using the provided hardware.

Reinstall driving lights bracket into HERD bumper using the provided hardware.



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12. Close the bumper and check fitment. Bumper position can be adjusted side to side and up or down as required. Once fitment is confirmed, tighten all mounting bolts to the required tensioning.




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13. Insert the nylon licence nuts (Item 24) into the square cutouts in the bumper and licence plate bracket (Item 11). Bolt the bracket into place using the No. 14 licence bolts (Item 25). The front four bolts can be used to mount a licence plate as needed. Figure 13 – License Plate Installation 14. 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16. If installing surface-mount signal lamps, 4LMPA001, apply at max 85 in-lbs (7ft-lbs, 9.6Nm)



## **Important**

- Check mounting points after the first 5000 km and every 3-6 month.
- This bumper is equipped with Herd Slam Latch which requires periodic adjustment. Refer to Slam Latch Installation adjustment instructions (S001) to properly adjust your Slam Latch.

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
